1. If your declaration covers donations you may make in the future:
 - Please notify us if you change your name or address while the declaration is still in force.
 - You can cancel the declaration at any time by notifying us in writing. We will then not apply for tax relief on donations you make on or after the date of cancellation.
2. You must pay an amount of income tax and/or capital gains tax at least equal to the tax that we can reclaim on your donation in each tax year. Currently we can claim back 28p for every pound you donate. This means that if you give us a donation of £100, you must pay at least £28 in tax each year.
3. If in the future your circumstances change and you no longer pay tax on your income and capital gains equal to the tax that we can reclaim, you should cancel your declaration.
4. If you pay tax at the higher rate you can claim further tax relief in your Self Assessment tax return.
5. If you are unsure whether your donations qualify for Gift Aid tax relief, or need help completing this form, please contact us and we will answer your questions. Alternatively, you can ask your local tax office for a leaflet IR113 Gift Aid which will explain the regulations for you.
